

Fabric Graphics Warranty

The Noteworthy Group, Inc., Beautiful Displays and The Fabric Factory warrant all fabric graphics against defects in materials or workmanship for a period of twelve (12) months from the date of purchase. Warranty does not apply to damage caused by rough handling and abuse and does not cover stains, rips, tears, punctures or other damages that can occur from mishandling of your graphics. Graphics must be returned to Beautiful Displays for inspection to determine cause of failure or damage to be eligible for warranty coverage. Graphics that are eligible will be repaired or replaced at our discretion. Please refer to the Important Fabric Graphic Care Tips section of this document for important information about getting the most from your fabric graphics.

Important Fabric Graphic Care Tips

- For light spot and dirt removal we recommend the use of a Mr. Clean Magic Eraser. These can be used dry or with water. Try using the Magic Eraser dry to begin with. This will easily remove many simple dirt and dust marks. Wet the Magic Eraser with water if the results are not satisfactory using it dry.
- For extra-difficult stains use the Magic Eraser in conjunction with either Resolve carpet cleaner or a Clorox Bleach Pen (do not use regular Clorox bleach). Soak the stain with the Resolve or Bleach Pen and let rest for one minute before rubbing with the Magic Eraser. We have found this combination will remove most stains satisfactorily without damaging the fabric.
- If you find the cleaned area dries with a noticeable spot, use a clean, wet cloth rag or towel and rub the spot and the area around the spot in a gentle circular motion to create a feathering effect which will diminish the appearance of the original spotted area after the fabric dries again.
- For laundering the whole graphic, machine wash in cold water on gentle cycle with a gentle fabric detergent. Air drying is best, but graphics may be tumble dried with no heat or low heat.
- Do not machine wash fabric prints that have blackout liners sewn in.
- Graphics may be steamed or steam ironed to remove wrinkles.
- Do not dry clean dye-sublimated fabric graphics.
